These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Department. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The municipality's capital assets records did not contain cost amounts for land.

The City's Water and Sewer Department received a letter from the Arkansas Department of Health dated May 28, 2020, which contained deficiencies noted in a Sanitary Survey completed February 5, 2020. The Sanitary Survey concluded, among other issues, the utility needs an elevated storage tank replacement because the tank's condition is too poor to restore. As of report date, the City has been unable to obtain funding due to an inadequate rate/fee structure and revenue to expense ratios, as noted in a Water Rate Study performed by the Rural Community Assistance Program dated February 2019. The City's General Fund has transferred funds to or directly paid expenses for the Department in the amounts of \$93,547, \$33,990, \$135,397, \$49,161, \$29,397, and \$61,017 for the years 2023, 2022, 2021, 2020, 2019, and 2018, respectively. The 2022 City of Altheimer Water and Sewer Department Audit Report, dated November 14, 2023, reflects an amount "Due to General Fund" at December 31, 2022, of \$410,657.
