City of Fouke, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Fouke, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2023, and have issued our report thereon dated March 27, 2025. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer System. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2023:

Mayor: Terry Purvis Recorder/Treasurer: Wanda Harris Police Chief/Marshal: Art Parrish

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of Mayor.

#### Mayor

An annual audit or agreed-upon procedures report has not been completed for the City's Water and Sewer System since 2014, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-234-119. The City signed an engagement letter on December 6, 2023, for the 2022, 2021, and 2020 years, however, the City has not received the reports and, as of the report date, the mayor has indicated they do not plan to honor the engagement letters. A similar finding was issued in the prior five reports dating back to 2015.

Street Fund disbursements exceeded budgeted appropriations by \$40,517 (44%), in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-58-203. A similar finding was issued in the prior report.

The governing body did not document the review of the prior report and accompanying comments at the first regularly scheduled meeting following receipt of the report, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-418.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local City government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
