City of Glenwood, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Glenwood, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2021 and 2020, and have issued our report thereon dated May 2, 2023. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Fund. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

Recorder/Treasurer: Sharon Nobel (resigned December 31, 2020)

Bridgette Moore (appointed December 31, 2020)

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of the Mayor.

Mayor

During August 2021, the Mayor took possession of City-owned asphalt millings from City property and used the millings at his personal residence and the residence of a family member. In August 2022, the Mayor was charged with Theft of Property and Abuse of Office, both Class A misdemeanors. As a result of a plea agreement, the Mayor was ordered to pay \$3,000 in restitution to the City and \$490 in court fines and fees, must resign from the office of Mayor, and may not seek election to any other public office.

City council minutes did not document the Council's review of findings and recommendations related to the prior report, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-418.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local City government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.

Bonds:

The Glenwood Water and Sewer Department had bond issues outstanding at December 31, 2021 and December 31, 2020 totaling \$7,338,196 and \$8,523,644, respectively. The bond proceeds were used for betterments and improvements to the water and sewer system. The bonds are secured by a pledge of sales and use tax revenues. This information was obtained from the "Glenwood Water and Sewer Department" audit report as prepared by TURNER, RODGERS, MANNING & PLYLER, PLLC Certified Public Accountants dated August 29, 2022 and May 31, 2021, respectively.
