A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Glenwood, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated September 12, 2024. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Fund. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

#### Bonds:

The Glenwood Water and Sewer Department had bond issues outstanding at December 31, 2022, totaling \$7,200,162. The bond proceeds were used for betterments and improvements to the water and sewer system. The bonds are secured by a pledge of sales and use tax revenues. This information was obtained from the "Glenwood Water and Sewer Department" audit report as prepared by TURNER, RODGERS, MANNING & PLYLER, PLLC Certified Public Accountants dated January 29, 2024. The 2023 audit report has not been completed.
