Additionally, we requested certain cash basis information and your acknowledgement of compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the year ended December 31, 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated July 25, 2024. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Department. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.
