Financial and Compliance Report

City of Horatio, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Horatio, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2022. Additionally, we requested certain cash basis information and your acknowledgement of compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the years ended December 31, 2021, and 2020, and have issued our report thereon dated June 13, 2023. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Department. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2022, 2021, and 2020:

Mayor: Richard Dorsey (Resigned September 3, 2021) Borden Neel (Appointed September 7, 2021) Recorder/Treasurer: Deborah Neel

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

During our evaluation, other matters came to our attention that would warrant disclosure in this report.

Other Matters

On March 23, 2022, the City initiated an ACH transaction totaling \$7,377 after receiving a fictitious payment request from an email address that appeared to belong to a vendor the City utilizes. Vendor personnel discovered the error on March 28, 2022, and notified the City. The City reported the incident to the respective financial institutions, as well as the City Attorney, Arkansas Municipal League, Sevier County Sheriff's Office, and Federal Bureau of Investigation. As of report date, the City had not recovered the funds.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local City government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
