## LEGISLATIVE JOINT AUDITING COMMITTEE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE AUDIT

Financial and Compliance Report

City of Hughes, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Hughes, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2021, and have issued our report thereon dated April 6, 2023. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Funds. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2021:

Mayor: Lincoln Barnett

Recorder/Treasurer: Sherry Thomas (Appointed February 8, 2021)
Police Chief: Thomas Freeman Miller (Resigned June 16, 2021)

Kristy Greene (Appointed June 16, 2021)

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of Recorder Treasurer.

#### Recorder/Treasurer

- 1. Prenumbered receipts were not issued for all items of income and receipted at the earliest opportunity, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-109. A similar finding was issued in the previous report.
- Restricted sales tax funds owed from previous years of \$26,340 were not transferred to the Sanitation Fund.
  Additionally, current year sales taxes of \$56,076 were not properly distributed, leaving a balance due at December 31,
  2021 of \$82,416, in noncompliance with St. Francis County Ordinance no. 94-211 (October 18, 1994). A similar
  finding was issued in the previous report.
- The City did not provide adequate supporting documentation for tested disbursements of \$14,896 (18%), in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-105.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local City government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
