Financial and Compliance Report

City of Hughes, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Hughes, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated October 12, 2023. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Funds. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2022:

Mayor: Lincoln Barnett Recorder/Treasurer: Sherry Thomas Police Chief: Kristy Greene

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of Recorder Treasurer.

Recorder/Treasurer

- 1. Prenumbered receipts were not issued for income at the earliest opportunity or sequentially, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-109. A similar finding was issued in the previous two reports dating back to 2020.
- Restricted sales tax funds owed from previous years of \$42,856 were not transferred to the Sanitation Fund, in noncompliance with St. Francis County Ordinance no. 94-211 (October 18, 1994). A similar finding was noted in the previous two reports dating back to 2020.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local City government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
