Financial and Compliance Report

City of Huttig, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Huttig, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated January 15, 2025. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Department. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2023 and 2022:

Mayor: Bennie Ford, Jr. (2023) Tony Cole (2022) Recorder/Treasurer: Rebecca Matthews

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the offices of Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer

#### Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer

Payroll taxes were not always paid to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) by the due dates. This resulted in penalties and interest of \$1,065 paid to the IRS.

#### Mayor

Competitive bids were not solicited, as required by Huttig Ordinance No. 133 (February 7, 2020). This Ordinance established the purchase authority of the Mayor without the need to engage in competitive bidding at \$5,000. A similar finding was noted in the previous three reports dating back to 2018.

The governing body did not review the prior report and accompanying comments and recommendations at the first regularly scheduled meeting following the receipt of the report, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-418.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local City government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
