City of Joiner, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Joiner, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2023, and have issued our report thereon dated April 28, 2025. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Department. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2023:

Mayor: Michelle Williams

Recorder/Treasurer: Josie Vasquez

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

During our evaluation, nothing came to our attention that would warrant disclosure in this report. Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of the **Recorder/Treasurer**.

Recorder/Treasurer

- 1. The bank statements for the General, Street, and Act 833 Funds were not properly reconciled, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-108. A similar finding was noted in the previous seven reports dating back to 2016.
- 2. The cash receipts and disbursements journals for General, Street, Act 833, and Public Safety Funds were not properly posted, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. §§ 14-59 -110, -111. A similar finding was noted in the previous two reports dating back to 2021.
- A separate account was maintained for the Street Fund as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-104; however, sanitation revenues and disbursements were comingled within the fund making the activity unclear as to Street funds being spent properly.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local City government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
