Financial and Compliance Report

City of Lakeview, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Lakeview, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2022 and 2021, and have issued our report thereon dated November 14, 2023. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2022 and 2021:

Mayor: Dennis Behling

Recorder/Treasurer: Kim Wallace District Court Clerk: Kim Wallace Police Chief: David Hotchkiss

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the offices of Recorder/Treasurer and District Court Clerk.

Recorder/Treasurer

The following issues were noted when reviewing payroll records:

- Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Quarterly 941 reports were not filed.
- State of Arkansas Transmittal of Tax and Wage Statements (AR3) was not provided for 2021.
- We were unable to determine if the appropriate taxes were withheld and remitted or wages reported were proper.

A similar finding was noted in the prior report.

District Court Clerk

Individual citations (e-tickets) were not reconciled to the arrest reports or court dockets by someone other than the District Court Clerk, who is designated as the official primarily responsible for the collection of fines, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 16-10-209. A similar finding was noted in the prior report.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local City government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
