We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Shannon Hills, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated May 16, 2023. These procedures were not performed for the Water, Sewer, and Fire Department Funds. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.
