Financial and Compliance Report

City of Central City, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Central City, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated July 30, 2024. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Department. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2023 and 2022:

Mayor: Terry Wallace

Recorder/Treasurer: Judith Lynne Miller Clerk/Bookkeeper: Tina Youngblood (May 23, 2023 – December 31, 2023) District Court Clerk: Teresa Harris

Police Chief: Daymon Blount (September 27, 2022 - December 31, 2023)

Dale Teague (January 1, 2022 – September 27, 2022)

We evaluated the City's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of Recorder/Treasurer.

#### Recorder/Treasurer

A review of payroll and employee leave records for the period January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023, revealed the following questionable payments, totaling \$4,980, to the District Court Clerk:

- \$2,925 in overpayments due to leave being taken before it was earned, which appears to conflict with Ark. Const. art. 12, § 5.
- \$1,792 in miscalculated holiday back pay.
- \$263 for miscalculated bonus pay.

In addition, the City is not in compliance with its internal policy concerning leave carryover amounts and leave payouts.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local City government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
