City of Highland, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the City of Highland, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2023. Additionally, we requested certain cash basis information and your acknowledgement of compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the year ended December 31, 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated November 25, 2024. These procedures were not performed for the Sewer Department. Management of the City is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.
