We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Big Flat, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated August 20, 2024. These procedures were not performed for the Water Fund. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.
