The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Bigelow, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2021 and 2020, and have issued our report thereon dated March 28, 2022. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Fund. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2021 and 2020:

Mayor: Bradley Akridge

Recorder/Treasurer: Diana Clements

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the offices of Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer.

#### Mayor

The minutes of the governing body did not document the review of the prior report by the governing body, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-418.

#### Recorder/Treasurer

A fixed asset listing was established, but did not include additions and deletions, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-107.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local Town government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties.
