Town of Bigelow, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Bigelow, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated April 10, 2024. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Funds. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

Recorder/Treasurer: Diana Clements

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of the Mayor.

The minutes of the governing body did not document the review of the prior report by the governing body, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-418. A similar finding was noted in the previous report.
