Financial and Compliance Report

Town of Bodcaw, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Bodcaw, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2021, and have issued our report thereon dated January 25, 2023. These procedures were not performed for the Water Department. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2021:

Mayor: Kimberly Hernandez Recorder/Treasurer: Martha May

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the offices of **Mayor** and **Recorder/Treasurer**.

Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer

In prior years, Street Fund monies of \$3,262 were used to pay the Recorder/Treasurer's salary. As of December 31, 2021, the General Fund owed the Street Fund \$1,462. A similar finding was issued in the prior two reports.

Mayor

The governing body did not adopt the budgets by ordinance or resolution, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-58-202.

Recorder/Treasurer

Annual financial statements were not posted, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-116.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local Town government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
