We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Bodcaw, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2024, and have issued our report thereon dated September 15, 2025. These procedures were not performed for the Water Department.
