We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Dell, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated May 18, 2023. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer and Sanitation Departments. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The council agreed for the General Fund to loan \$1,362,525 (\$865,280 in 2016 and \$497,245 in 2017) to the Water Department for this construction. The payment schedule reflects monthly payments of \$6,505 being made from the Water Department to General Fund beginning June 1, 2017 through May 1, 2047 with an interest rate of 4%.
