Town of Dell, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Dell, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2023, and have issued our report thereon dated June 20, 2024. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer and Sanitation Departments. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

4. The Town of Dell completed construction of a new water plant in 2017. The council agreed for the General Fund to loan \$1,362,525 (\$865,280 in 2016 and \$497,245 in 2017) to the Water Department for this construction. The payment schedule reflects monthly payments of \$6,505 being made from the Water Department to General Fund beginning June 1, 2017 through May 1, 2047, with an interest rate of 4%.
