Financial and Compliance Report

Town of Denning, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Denning, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2021 and 2020, and have issued our report thereon dated June 5, 2023. These procedures were not performed for the Water Department. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2021 and 2020:

Mayor: Paul Lee

Recorder/Treasurer: Donna Thomas (deceased September 20, 2021)

Candice Harmon (appointed January 2022)

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the offices of Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer.

Mayor

An annual audit or agreed-upon procedures report has not been completed for the City's Water Department for the years 2021 through 2017, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-234-119.

Bank reconciliations for 2021 were not approved by a municipal official or employee, other than the person preparing the reconciliation, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-108.

In 2021 and 2020 budgets were not adopted by ordinance or resolution, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-58-202.

Recorder/Treasurer

Prenumbered receipts were not issued in 2021 for all funds received, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-109.

Cash receipts and disbursements journals were not maintained in 2020, as required by Ark. Code Ann. §§ 14-59-110, -111.

Supporting documentation was not maintained for disbursements tested, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-

Prenumbered checks were not issued for all disbursements, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-105.

A detailed fixed asset listing was not established, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-107.

Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Forms 941 and State of Arkansas ARW-3 form were not provided for inspection for 2020, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-114. In addition, authorized salaries for the Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer could not be determined for 2021 and 2020.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local Town government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
