Financial and Compliance Report

Town of Jacksonport, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Jacksonport, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2021 and 2020, and have issued our report thereon dated September 27, 2022. These procedures were not performed for the Water and Sewer Department. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2021 and 2020:

Mayor: Marcus Dodson Recorder/Treasurer: Deanna Dodson

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the offices of Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer.

#### Mayor

- 1. The minutes of the governing body did not document the review of the findings and recommendations and the action taken by the governing body for the prior report, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-418.
- 2. The 2021 and 2020 budgets were not adopted by ordinance or resolution, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-58-202.

#### **Recorder/Treasurer**

- 1. Prenumbered receipts were not issued for all funds received, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-109. A similar finding was issued in previous reports dating back to 2010.
- 2. Cash receipts and disbursements journals were not properly classified and did not have yearly totals for each fund, as required by Ark. Code Ann. §§ 14-59-110, -111. A similar finding was noted in previous reports dating back to 2011.
- 3. Bank accounts were not properly reconciled, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-108. A similar finding was issued in previous reports dating back to 2008.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local Town government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
