We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Pineville, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2022 and 2021, and have issued our report thereon dated October 26, 2023. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.
