We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Rudy, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2024. Additionally, we requested certain cash basis information and your acknowledgement of compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated April 22, 2025. These procedures were not performed for the Community Park Commission. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.
