Financial and Compliance Report

Town of Shirley, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Shirley, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022, and have issued our report thereon dated October 7, 2024. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2023 and 2022:

Mayor: Lisa Hackett Recorder/Treasurer: Vacant (October 24, 2023 – December 31, 2023) Melissa Worthing (Resigned October 23, 2023)

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the offices of Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer.

Mayor

Total disbursements for the Street Fund in 2022 exceeded appropriations by \$27,678 (107%), in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-58-203.

Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer

Town deposits totaling \$154,338 and \$112,961 were uninsured and uncollateralized on December 31, 2023 and 2022, respectively, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 19-8-107.
