## LEGISLATIVE JOINT AUDITING COMMITTEE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE AUDIT

Financial and Compliance Report

Town of Tupelo, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Tupelo, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2023, and have issued our report thereon dated November 4, 2024. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The finding contained in this section relates to the following officials who held office during 2023:

Mayor: Hannah Garner (Appointed July 31, 2023) Melissa Runyon (Resigned July 31, 2023)

Recorder/Treasurer: Chelsea Golden

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of Recorder/Treasurer.

#### Recorder/Treasurer

Restricted funds from previous years of \$2,913 were not transferred to the Street Fund from the General Fund, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-104. The City Council passed Resolution 2023-5, to pay 10% of general revenues to the Street Fund each year until the balance is paid in full. Payments of \$4,500 were made in 2023 in compliance with Resolution 2023-5 to reduce the balance owed to the Street Fund. A similar finding was noted in the previous three reports.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local Town government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
