A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Vandervoort, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2021, 2020, and 2019, and have issued our report thereon dated August 10, 2022. These procedures were not performed for the Water Department. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

An annual audit or agreed upon procedures report for the Town's Water System was not obtained and submitted to Arkansas Legislative Audit for 2020 and 2019, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-234-119.
