A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Fargo, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2021 and 2020, and have issued our report thereon dated June 30, 2023. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2021 and 2020:

Mayor: Linda Collins

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of the Mayor.

Accounting procedures for municipalities are set forth in the Municipal Accounting Law, Ark. Code Ann. §§ 14-59-101 – 14-59-119. The Town was in noncompliance with these codes and other proper accounting procedures during the fiscal years 2021 and 2020 as noted below:

- A budget was not adopted and maintained.
- Bank reconciliations were not prepared monthly for the General, Street, and Community Center Funds.
- Financial statements were not provided to the Town Council members on a monthly basis.
- An annual financial statement was not prepared and published.
- Town Council minutes were not maintained.
- Prenumbered receipts were not issued for General, Street, and Community Center Funds.
- Receipts journals were not prepared.
- Disbursements journals were not prepared.
- A fixed asset listing was not provided.
- Invoices or supporting documentation were not provided.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local Town government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
