Financial and Compliance Report

Town of Georgetown, Arkansas Officials and Council Members Legislative Joint Auditing Committee

A priority of Arkansas Legislative Audit is to assist local government officials by promoting sound financial management and accountability of government resources. The Legislative Auditor reports on the fiscal affairs of local governments, as well as compliance with relevant state laws and observance of good business practices to provide accountability for tax dollars expended to support government operations.

We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Georgetown, Arkansas, as of and for the years ended December 31, 2021 and 2020, and have issued our report thereon dated May 6, 2022. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

The findings contained in this section relate to the following officials who held office during 2021 and 2020:

Mayor: Ron Snyder

Recorder/Treasurer: Debra Bryant

We evaluated the Town's compliance with certain state laws concerning general and district court accounting, budgeting, purchasing, and investing and depositing of public funds.

Noncompliance with state law and accepted accounting practices was noted in the office of Recorder/Treasurer.

#### Recorder/Treasurer:

- The City's accounts were under collateralized by \$202,687 (45% of total deposits) at December 31, 2021, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 19-8-107.
- 2. Prenumbered receipts were not issued for all funds received in the Street Fund, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-109.
- 3. A fixed asset listing was established, but did not include all additions, as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-107.
- Adequate supporting documentation was not maintained for tested disbursements of \$2,453 (15%) in 2020, in noncompliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 14-59-105.
- 5. The following issues were noted concerning the Town's 2021 and 2020 payroll:
  - Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Quarterly 941 Forms were not provided.
  - Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration Form AR3 was not provided.

We were unable to determine if the proper amounts of withholdings were remitted; therefore additional penalties and interest could be due.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, local Town government, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
