We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Town of Etowah, Arkansas, as of and for the year ended December 31, 2023, and have issued our report thereon dated December 9, 2024. These procedures were not performed for the Sewer Fund and Water and Waste Disposal System. Management of the Town is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.
