We have performed certain limited procedures with respect to cash basis financial information and compliance with certain state laws and accepted accounting practices for the Prosecuting Attorney, Fourth Judicial District as of and for the years ended December 31, 2021 and 2020, and have issued our report thereon dated August 18, 2022. The Prosecuting Attorney is responsible for maintaining the financial records and complying with state laws and accepted accounting practices.

During our evaluation, nothing came to our attention that would warrant disclosure in this report, except for the following:

Six unauthorized withdrawals totaling \$3,288 were made from the Prosecuting Attorney's bank account in October 2021 and November 2021. Entity personnel discovered the unauthorized withdrawals upon reconciliation of the affected bank account, and the funds were recovered from the bank.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, the Prosecuting Attorney, state executive and oversight management, and other parties as required by Arkansas Code, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. However, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 10-4-417, all reports presented to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee are matters of public record and distribution is not limited.
