Members of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee:

This letter reports law enforcement agencies' calendar year 2025 compliance with the asset seizure and forfeiture requirements of Ark. Code Ann. §§ 5-5-601 to -612. Arkansas Code provides forfeiture procedures for seized assets that were used in commission of the crime of human trafficking under the Human Trafficking Act of 2013.

According to the Human Trafficking Coordinator, no asset seizures related to human trafficking occurred from January 1, 2025 through February 26, 2026. Due to the absence of human trafficking-related seizures, no additional audit steps were necessary to ensure that property was seized, recorded, and adjudicated in accordance with Arkansas Code.
